### Pastors Corner

**JUNE 2017** 

Our Listening Team has been at work since our first seminar in August of 2016. Much of our work takes place in ways that makes it difficult for the congregation to know what is happening. I thought it would therefore be helpful to give some information about what happens on the Listening Team. Please feel free to ask any of the members of the team for more information, as well.

#### Who are the members of the Listening Team?

Pastor Jessica, Nelson Jonas, Helen Knoll, and Becky Greathouse are the current members of the Listening Team. This team formed at the end of the summer and was officially commissioned in October. Now that Pastor Jessica is leaving as pastor/mission developer of New Hope, we are looking to add another member or members to the team.

#### When does the Listening Team meet?

The Listening Team does not have a regularly scheduled meeting time. We meet when we have specific tasks to accomplish. Now that we are moving into the community listening portion of our work, we will meet more often with community members than as a team. Our next regular meeting (at which all are welcome) will happen at the end of June.

#### What is the work of the Listening Team?

The Listening Team is the group working on the Missional River process—the goal of this process is to help us become more deeply rooted in the community. The Listening Team's task is to listen to God at work in three ways: through Scripture reading and prayer, through the congregation, and through the community. Although we are moving through these listenings, we do not leave one behind for the next. It is a building process. Currently, we are in the midst of the congregational listening, but we continue to devote time to prayer and Bible study. We will soon reach out into the community, but we will not ignore the congregation or our prayer and study as a result.

The Listening Team's goal is not to magically make more people come to worship or join New Hope. Rather, it is to make connections and build relationships in Blanco. We believe that God is already at work in each of us, at New Hope, and in Blanco. We are listening to discover where God is and how we can join in the work that God is doing. To this end, we listen to hear how God is revealed in Scripture, how you perceive God at work at New Hope, and what God is doing amongst the people of Blanco. We hope to discover places where a need exists in Blanco, and use our understanding and rootedness to help be a part of the solution. We know that communities are not as well connected as they used to be, and that shifts in the way churches work have made us even less connected to our neighborhood and the world immediately around us. The Listening Team hopes to lessen that disconnect and work to help Blanco be the kind of community where people's needs are met by the passions of others—a place where everyone knows that they are cared for as children of God.

Perhaps the work of the Listening Team sounds somewhat confusing or not very specific. In fact, the nature of this work is that we will not truly know our goals or the outcome of the process until we are near the end. We are listening *so that* we can discover to what New Hope has been called in this community. Why are we here? Why did God bring this group of people together in this place? What is God leading us to do? What are the gifts we have? What are the needs of the community? How can we be people who deepen relationships, root ourselves in the neighborhood, and create a web of community? We continue to work to discover this as our listening process continues.
