Reformation - 500th year celebration

Traditionally, 31 October 1517 is widely held to be the day German monk Martin Luther nailed his Ninety-five Theses on the door of the All Saints' Church in Wittenberg, Electorate of Saxony within the Holy Roman Empire. The nailing of the Ninety-five Theses sparked the discussion about Catholic beliefs and practices of the day

Until the 20th century, most Lutheran churches celebrated Reformation Day on October 31, regardless of which day of the week it occurred. Today, most Lutheran churches transfer the festival, so that it falls on the Sunday (called **Reformation Sunday**) on or before October 31 and transfer All Saints' Day to the Sunday on or after November 1.

The liturgical color of the day is red, which represents the Holy Spirit and the Martyrs of the Christian Church. Luther's hymn, A Mighty Fortress is our God is traditionally sung on this day.

Members of New Hope Lutheran will travel on Sunday October 29th to Fredericksburg to join a 500th year celebration of the Reformation. In the coming weeks, Pastor Ann we will continue to instruct us in the teachings of Martin Luther and the significance of the Reformation.
